ROOF PIPES

Openings around roof pipes can allow wildlife in.

ATTIC VENTS

Small openings in attic vents can be access points.

GAPS IN SIDING

Cracks or holes in siding can be used to get inside.

UTILITY LINES

Openings around wires, pipes, and cables can be entry points.

FOUNDATION GAPS

Openings in the foundation or where materials meet can allow wildlife inside.

RIDGE VENTS

Gaps along the roof ridge are common entry points.

CHIMNEY GAPS

Uncapped or damaged chimneys can allow animals to enter.

SOFFITS & EAVES

Gaps or damage in these areas provide easy access.

GARAGE DOOR GAPS

Gaps around or under garage doors can be easy access.

DOOR SWEEPS & THRESHOLDS

Worn or missing sweeps can leave a gap at the bottom of doors.

CRAWL SPACE VENTS

Missing or damaged screens can allow wildlife inside.
