

SIGNS OF EXTERIOR ACTIVITY

ARMADILLOS



Common signs of armadillos include shallow digging, disturbed mulch, cone or football shaped holes / burrows near foundations or landscaping.

MOLES



Common signs of moles include raised tunnels, soft or spongy ground, volcano-shaped mounds, and dying patches of grass

RACCOONS



Common signs of raccoons include knocked-over trash, damaged rooflines, muddy paw prints, and digging around your property and using the bathroom in exterior pools or hot tubs

SIGNS OF INTERIOR ACTIVITY

RACCOONS



Common signs of raccoons inside a structure include crushed insulation, nesting material, large droppings, and visible roof or soffit damage.

SQUIRRELS



Common signs of squirrels include chewed wood, damaged insulation, nesting material, and gnaw marks around entry points.

RODENTS



Common signs of rodents include droppings, chewed wires, gnaw marks, nesting material, and damaged insulation.
